Automated checks possible

The model checking function marks the first step in the integration of the bimspot solution , which was taken over by smino .

The visual check and version comparison of BIM models is already possible today using the smino viewer. Automatic model checks in the form of collision and quality checks are now being added.

The models are automatically searched for errors based on rules. For example, collisions between concrete walls and ventilation ducts can be found, or whether room boundaries have been modeled correctly. These errors can then be converted directly into tasks on smino and also exported to correct the models. This saves time and ultimately money for users.
