City of Vienna is the first megacity to use smino

Rapperswil, April 9, 2024 – The City of Vienna relies on smino 's software solution for planning and construction projects – as do two major German cities.

smino , the digital tool for builders, architects, planners and construction companies, is now being used by two Wien Holding companies: Wiener Infrastructure Project GmbH (WIP) and Wiener Location Development GmbH (WSE). The managing director of Darmstädter Stadtentwicklungs GmbH, Sven Kling, is delighted with the introduction of the smino platform: "Thanks to smino, we can realize our construction projects digitally and efficiently.
